

RESOLUTION 2014 - 07

A Resolution of support relative to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Transportation 2014-2018 Alternatives Program (TAP) award cycle toward a Shorewood bicycle share.

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Shorewood, supports the pre-scoping and a second-round TAP application to be submitted to WisDOT for the 2014-2018 award cycle. The purpose of the application is to seek federal grant funding to establish a bicycle share program in the Village of Shorewood; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Shorewood, recognizes that WisDOT reimburses project sponsors for the federal share of eighty (80) percent of the approved TAP project costs, up to the limit of the federal award amount. In light of the minimum twenty (20) percent match requirement, the Village of Shorewood will work toward securing the matching funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Board of the Village of Shorewood, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin authorizes staff to apply for a second round TAP application. If the Village of Shorewood is awarded funding by WisDOT for the 2014-2018 TAP Award cycle, the Village of Shorewood is authorized to accept the award administered by WisDOT and will submit another resolution for Village Board consideration relative to establishing the necessary agreements with WisDOT for the above referenced project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village of Shorewood agrees to comply with all applicable laws, requirements as outlined in the WisDOT 2014-2018 TAP application materials, the state-municipal agreement between WisDOT and the Village of Shorewood, and any other program and/or project documentation.
