Dumpsters & PODS

To obtain a permit for a dumpster or POD:

- Complete a Temporary Storage & Dumpster on Private Property Permit OR Obstruct the Public Right of Way Permit
- Pay the fee (\$75)
- Submit a copy of the required insurance with the Village of Shorewood named as an additional insured (if applicable)

The following rules apply:

- A dumpster/POD must be at least 25 feet from a fire hydrant.
- A dumpster/POD can not be placed in any NO PARKING zone and must obey all Village of Shorewood parking restrictions.
- All public ways and public grounds must be left in as good and clean condition as they were. Costs for damages, cleaning or maintenance will be billed to the applicant.
- A certificate of insurance indicating that the applicant or provider of the storage unit holds comprehensive general liability insurance in the amount of \$500,000 for each individual, \$1,000,000 for each occurrence and \$500,000 for property damage. This must indicate the Village of Shorewood as an additional insured.
- No permit shall be issued where the Building Inspector determines that the placing of the dumpster/storage unit will unreasonably interfere with the public health, safety or welfare.
- Permits may be denied where there is not enough room for the dumpster or storage unit upon the premises or private property served.
- Flashing barricades on each end of the job site OR reflective tape on or around the container are REQUIRED.
- A dumpster or POD may not be placed until the permit application is completed and approved.
