

RESOLUTION – 2020 – 11A

A RESOLUTION TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING SECTIONS 514-49 G (2) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE – SEWER UTILITY PENALTY

WHEREAS, COVID-19, a novel strain of the coronavirus, was detected in December 2019, and has subsequently spread throughout numerous countries and the United States, including Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization’s declaration of a Public Health Emergency of International concern, and the United States Department of Health and Human Services declaration of a Public Health Emergency, the State of Wisconsin has declared a Public Health Emergency by Executive Order #72; and,

WHEREAS, the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) has issued orders to suspend the assessment of late fees on regulated municipal utilities; and,

WHEREAS, the Shorewood Municipal Sewer Utility fees are billed in tandem with the Shorewood Municipal Water Utility; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Shorewood municipal code sections 514-49 G (2) establish a penalty for past due Sewer Utility balances; and,

WHEREAS, the consistent application of utility penalties between the Shorewood Municipal Water and Sewer Utilities is desirable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Board of the Village of Shorewood temporarily suspends municipal ordinance 514-49 G (2) until such time that Public Service Commission of Wisconsin rescinds their order to suspend the assessment of late fees on past due balances.
