**Call to Order:** Chairperson Tr. Ircink called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. at the Village Hall.

1. Discussion Points

- Project history – project schedule of 2022 deferred to 2025 in recognition of pandemic impact on business district
- Project scope – project approved as pavement replacement with watermain, not reconstruction. Design engineering contract includes review of pedestrian and traffic safety enhancements identified in Transportation and Parking Analysis, Pedestrian and Bicycle Master Plan and green infrastructure enhancements outlined in Green Infrastructure Guidebook.
- Resident/participant comments and question topics included:
  - Concern that traffic-calming measures would divert traffic to adjacent residential streets
  - Upgrade of streetlight system
  - Bump-out locations
  - Crosswalks
  - Bus stop locations
  - Traffic signals at Kensington
  - Metro Market area modifications
  - Stormwater trees/green infrastructure
- Acknowledgement that meeting purpose was to review concepts related to pedestrian/traffic safety and green infrastructure enhancements specifically identified in RFP and project scope. Detailed questions regarding design application to be reviewed following advancement of recommended concept(s).

2. Follow Up-Items – identify and address additional Tr. Stokebrand questions.

Trustee Moore Baldauff moved to advance recommended design concepts for full Village Board review. Motion was seconded by Trustee Bockhorst and passed, 3-0.
