ORDINANCE NO. 312

AN ORDINANCE CREATING SECTION 319-11.2, "FACE COVERING REQUIREMENTS DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC," OF ARTICLE II, "GENERAL REGULATIONS," OF CHAPTER 319, "HEALTH AND SANITATION," OF THE SHOREWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, As of July 7, 2020, COVID-19 cases have been on the rise in Wisconsin, Milwaukee County and the North Shore in recent weeks.

WHEREAS, Public spaces and businesses are open for in-person operations in the North Shore, increasing the potential for further community spread of COVID-19.

WHEREAS, According to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the effectiveness of face coverings at reducing the spread of COVID-19 is highest when masks are widely used by people in public settings. In settings where physical distancing is difficult to maintain, everyone wearing a face mask reduces the risk of transmission.

WHEREAS, COVID-19 is primarily spread via respiratory droplets when people are in close proximity with each other and people that are infected speak, sneeze, or cough. People can be infected and have no symptoms (asymptomatic) and they are still able to transmit the virus.

WHEREAS, INSERT LANGUAGE CONCERNING THE EXISTING AND ACTIVE HEALTH EMERGENCY DECLARATION;

NOW THEREFORE, at a regular meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Shorewood, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, held on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2020, by a favorable vote of the members being present and therefore, said Board does ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1**

Section 319-11.2, "Face covering requirements during the Covid-19 pandemic," of Article II, "General Regulations," of Chapter 319, "Health and Sanitation," of the Municipal Code of the Village of Shorewood is hereby created as follows:

**319-11.2 Face covering requirements during the Covid-19 pandemic.**

A. As used in this section, the following terms shall have the meaning indicated:

**FACE COVERING**

A protective mask covering the nose and mouth, including cloth face coverings or surgical masks as described by the centers for disease control and prevention.

**B. MASK REQUIRED INDOORS.**

For the duration of Shorewood’s existing emergency declaration order, any person 2 years old or older who is present in the Village of Shorewood shall have possession of a face covering when the person leaves home or other place of residence and shall wear the face covering whenever the person is in an indoor public space.

**C. MASK REQUIRED OUTDOORS.**

For the duration of Shorewood’s existing emergency declaration order, any person 2 years old or older who is present in the Village of Shorewood shall have possession of a face covering when the person leaves home or other place of residence and shall wear the face covering whenever the person is in an outdoor public space and sees a person within 30 feet who is not a member of the person’s family or household.

**D. MASK REQUIRED FOR CITY FACILITIES AND EMPLOYEES.**

The Village Manager shall establish a face covering requirement policy for Village employees and other persons on the premises of any Village facility.

**E. EXCEPTIONS.**

Exceptions for face coverings will be made under the following circumstances:

1. Persons under 2 years of age.
2. Persons who fall into the Center for Disease Control and Prevention’s guidelines for those who should not wear face coverings due to a medical condition, mental health condition, developmental disability, or are otherwise covered under the Americans with disabilities act.
3. Persons who have upper-respiratory chronic conditions and silent disabilities.
4. Persons in settings where it is not practical or feasible to wear face coverings, including when obtaining or rendering goods or services, such as the receipt of dental services or medical treatments.

**F. PENALTY.** The health department shall enforce this section. Any business failing to enforce sub. 1, as determined by the health department, shall be given a warning and an opportunity for compliance, followed by a citation of not less than \$50 nor more than \$500. If a business fails to enforce sub. 1 more than twice, the North Shore Health Department may shut down the business to protect public health and stop the spread of the virus. A business has the right to refuse service to any person for failure to comply with sub. 1. If any person continues to violate sub. 1, a citation may be issued to the individual in lieu of the business.

**SECTION 2**

That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby to such extent repealed.

**SECTION 3**

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and posting.
