**NOTICE IS GIVEN** that the **Board of Review for the Village of Shorewood, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, is scheduled to reconvene on Tuesday, September 26, 2023 at 5:30 p.m.** for the purpose of hearing the adjourned appeals of The Kroger, Roundy's Supermarket, Inc., tax no. 240-0054-003, Baisch residence, tax no. 236-0040-000, Davida residence, tax no. 238-0008-000, and possible final adjournment of the 2023 Board of Review if these appeals are complete. **The meeting will take place via \*video conference only.**

**Pursuant to S. 70.47(2), Wis. Stats.:**

No person shall be allowed to appear before the Board of Review, to testify to the Board by \*telephone or to contest the amount of any assessment of real or personal property if the person has refused a reasonable written request, by certified mail, of the Assessor to enter onto the property to conduct an exterior view of such property being assessed.

After the first meeting of the Board of Review and before the Board's final adjournment, no person who is scheduled to appear before the Board of Review may contact, or provide information to, a member of the Board about that person's objection except at a session of the Board.

When appearing before the Board of Review, the person shall specify, in writing, the person's estimate of the value of the land and of the improvements that are the subject of the person's objection and specify the information that the person used to arrive at that estimate.

No person may appear before the Board of Review, testify to the Board by telephone or object to a valuation; if that valuation was made by the Assessor or the objector using the income method; unless the person supplies to the Assessor all of the information about income and expenses, as specified in the Assessor's manual under s. 73.03 (2a), that the Assessor requests. The municipality or county shall provide by ordinance for the confidentiality of information about income and expenses that is provided to the Assessor under this paragraph and shall provide exceptions for persons using the information in the discharge of duties imposed by law or of the duties of their office or by order of a court. The information that is provided under this paragraph, unless a court determines that it is inaccurate, is not subject to the right of inspection and copying under Wis. Stats. 19.35 (1).
