Minutes of October 6, 2021

Diane Buck called the meeting to order at 8:30am.

Meeting minutes of September were approved - moved and seconded by Vonderberg and Weber.

1. Continuing with the discussions of the property at CAPTOL AND OAKLAND: For the bus stop area, Debra suggested the Chicago artist, Edna Soto - see Grant Park. Diane and Ellie have suggested more natural look with greenery. For the north side, we understand the owners are considering projecting images. The two problems with this idea might be equipment problems or disturbing the neighbors. A mural would work 24/7. Two muralist names were mentioned, Jenny Jo Wennlund and Emma Daisy. Diane will forward these comments to Pat Algiers.
2. GHOST TRAIN is currently not working. Mary Peck, the designer, has been contacted and will meet at the site on October 13th with Ellie, Diane, Dick, and Pat to trouble shoot the problems with the lights and the audio. We will pay Marty a fee for his work.

3. GHOST TRAIN MAINTENANCE is absolutely necessary! Ellie made the point that we need access and gain possession of the program file that Marty currently holds. Diane will reach out to ClearWing and Pro Audio Design to determine interest. Ellie has good communication with Signify and will continue to work on the material for the repairs with Kevin Power. Ellie will also work with the DPW for access to the boxes.
4. WEBSITE BIOS Last call for six sentences to Jesse.
5. SHOREWOOD ARTS FESTIVAL conversation continued. Diane is doubtful of SPS interest but will call Jennifer Anderson. If only Hubbard Park was available poetry, artists, and comedy could be done. Would the Artists Guild use Hubbard Lodge? Art Market? How could we hire a coordinator? Date?
6. TRAFFIC SIGNAL BOXES OR codes are complete and Confluence invoice submitted to the Foundation. Debra agreed to stock maps at Box 1 and 7 next summer and fall.
7. NEW BUSINESS November 11 Art at the Atrium.
