1. Call to order

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 p.m.

2. Consider Approval of April 9, 2019 Minutes

There have been over 620 community survey responses as of last Friday. Results will be shared with the committee in June or July. The #WalkShorewood campaign has started. 7. Discuss People for Bikes Grant

Grant application deadline is Fall 2019. Mr. Burkart will reach out to Milwaukee County Parks staff to inquire if they'd be interested in having a pump park in one of their parks.

8. Discuss Community Involvement with Bike Friendly Application

Ms. Ellerman summarized some discussions with Sandie Pendleton about coordinating a community forum on preparation for the bike friendly application. Ms. Ellerman will reach out to Sandie to hear more specifics on his vision for a community engagement process and invite him to the June meeting.
