ORDINANCE NO. 3043

AMENDING SUBSECTION 514-12 REPLACEMENT AND REPAIR OF SERVICE PIPES

WHEREAS, The Village of Shorewood is responsible to provide safe drinking water to our residents; and

WHEREAS, the risk of lead exposure from corroding lead drinking water service lines is well documented; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Shorewood has many public and privately-owned existing lead water service lines which would require replacement to mitigate these risks; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Shorewood has been systematically replacing publicly owned lead service line connections during water main replacement projects or whenever such service connections need to be repaired; and

WHEREAS, a systematic replacement of the Village's privately-owned lead water service lines is both desirable to improve long-term public safety, as well as necessary for managing utility operations; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Shorewood must also meet the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resource requirements for local compliance with the federal Lead and Copper Rule; and

WHEREAS, the development of mandatory replacement requirements for privately-owner lead service lines will help to effectively achieve these goals,

WHEREAS, the development of mandatory replacement requirements for privately-owner lead service line connections is required by the Public Service Commission (PSC) in order for the utility to apply for approval of a Financial Assistance Program for Private Lead Service Lateral replacements,

WHEREAS, the approval of a Financial Assistance Program for Private Lead Service Lateral replacements by the PSC will allow for the utility to contribute up to 50% of the costs for replacing customer lead service lines,

NOW THEREFORE, at a regular meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Shorewood, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, held on the 6th day of June 2022, by a favorable vote of the members being present and therefore, said Board does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1

The following will be added as Subsection D to section 514-12: "Effective September 30, 2022 the village shall require the mandatory replacement of all utility and customer lead service lines upon the subsequent replacement of the utility's water mains connecting to those services, should any such service line need to be repaired, or any other project be developed for the explicit purpose of replacing lead service lines. Financial assistance to customers for the replacement of customer side service lines containing lead (LSL's) will be provided by the water utility in accordance with the village's adopted Lead Service Line Replacement Program."


SECTION 2

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and posting.
