

ORDINANCE NUMBER: #2072

An Ordinance Creating a Loading Zone on East Capitol Drive

At a regular meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Shorewood, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, held on this 21st day of February 2017, a quorum being present and a majority of the Board voting therefore, said Board finds:

WHEREAS, because of the time in which they were constructed, many of the commercial properties in Shorewood’s commercial district were not constructed to accommodate deliveries at a side or rear entrance; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of “loading zones” is necessary to accommodate the continued use of older buildings for commercial purposes; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of a loading zone in front of the property at 2107 E. Capitol Drive serves the interest of re-appropriating that property to a commercial use;

At a regular meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Shorewood, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, held on this 21st day of February 2017, a quorum being present and a majority of the Board voting therefore, said Board does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1

That Section 500-24, Loading Zones of Chapter 500 of the General Ordinances of the Village of Shorewood be amended and supplemented to add Section 500-24(H) to read as follows:

- (H) On the south side of East Capitol Drive from a point beginning 32 feet east of the interior crosswalk mark at Capitol Drive and North Frederick Avenue, and continuing 48 feet eastward on Capitol, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 10:00 a.m. to midnight Friday through Sunday.

SECTION 2

That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby to such extent repealed.

SECTION 3


That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and posting.
