

RESOLUTION – 2020 - 11

A RESOLUTION REDUCING CLASS “B” AND “CLASS B” INTOXICATING LIQUOR AND MALT BEVERAGE, “CLASS C” WINE LICENSE 2020 RENEWAL FEE AND WAIVING THE LATE FEE FOR RESTAURANTS AND BARS IN THE VILLAGE OF SHOREWOOD WHO ARE CLOSED OR SERVING LIMITED CAPACITY DUE TO COVID-19

WHEREAS, COVID-19, a novel strain of the coronavirus, was detected in December 2019 and has subsequently spread throughout numerous countries and the United States, including Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, international, federal, state, county and local governments are all working together to contain COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization’s declaration of a Public Health Emergency of international concern and the United States’ Department of Health and Human Services declaration of a Public Health Emergency, the State of Wisconsin has declared a Public Health Emergency by Executive Order #72; and

WHEREAS, the Village President of Shorewood by Resolution 2020-02, passed on March 16, 2020, declared a Public Health Emergency Response to COVID-19 coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 response has caused a dire economic situation for the Village of Shorewood and its for-profit businesses, having been closed or restricted in operation pursuant to Emergency Order #12 “Safer at Home” Order, may need financial assistance in the form of fee reduction; and

WHEREAS, Shorewood Village Code 335-4 requires a “Class B” renewal fee of \$500, Class “B” renewal fee of \$100 and “Class C” renewal fee of \$100 respectively; Wisconsin State Statute §125.26(3)(e)1 provides a fee of \$50-\$500 for “Class B” licenses, Wisconsin State Statute §125.26(4) provides a fee not to exceed \$100 for Class “B” licenses and Wisconsin State Statute §125.51(3m)(e) provides a fee not to exceed \$100 for “Class C” Wine; and

WHEREAS, the \$100 late fee listed in the Village fee schedule will be waived for the period of July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Board of the Village of Shorewood does hereby resolve that the fees for “Class B” intoxicating liquor license renewals be reduced from \$500 to \$250 and the Class “B” fermented malt beverage license be reduced from \$100 to \$50 and the “Class C” wine license be reduced from \$100 to \$50 for the period on July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2021 for restaurants and bars that are closed or serving in limited capacity.
