

Resolution No. 2020-29

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF NOT TO EXCEED
\$5,875,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION CORPORATE PURPOSE BONDS, SERIES 2020C

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Shorewood, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin (the "Village") has adopted initial resolutions (the "Initial Resolutions") authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds for the following public purposes and in the following amounts:

- (a) \$4,705,000 for financing street improvement projects;
- (b) \$760,000 for financing the construction of police facilities;
- (c) \$255,000 for financing improvements to parks and public grounds; and
- (d) \$165,000 for financing facilities and equipment for the North Shore Fire Department.

WHEREAS, the Village Board hereby finds and determines that the projects described in the Initial Resolutions are within the Village's power to undertake and therefore serve a "public purpose" as that term is defined in Section 67.04(1)(b), Wisconsin Statutes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Board of the Village that:

Section 1. Combination of Issues. The issues referred to above are hereby combined into one issue of bonds designated "General Obligation Corporate Purpose Bonds, Series 2020C" (the "Bonds"). The Bonds shall be issued in an amount not to exceed \$5,875,000 with the amount issued for each purpose being specified in a subsequent resolution of the Village Board.

Section 2. Sale of the Bonds. The Village Board hereby authorizes and directs that the Bonds be offered for public sale. At a subsequent meeting, the Village Board shall consider such bids for the Bonds as may have been received and take action thereon.

Section 3. Notice of Sale. The Village Clerk, in consultation with the Village's financial advisor, Baker Tilly Municipal Advisors, LLC ("Baker Tilly MA"), is hereby authorized and directed to cause the sale of the Bonds to be publicized at such times and in such manner as the Village Clerk may determine and to cause copies of a complete Official Term of Offering and other pertinent data to be forwarded to interested bidders as the Village Clerk may determine.

Section 4. Official Statement. The Village Clerk (in consultation with Baker Tilly MA) shall also cause an Official Statement to be prepared and distributed. The appropriate Village officials shall determine when the Official Statement is final for purposes of Securities and Exchange Commission Rule 15c2-12 and shall certify said Statement, such certification to constitute full authorization of such Statement under this resolution.
