

ORDINANCE NO. 3030

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION 500-26 WINTER PARKING

WHEREAS, the Village of Shorewood undertook a comprehensive Transportation and Parking Analysis in 2019, which was formally received by the Village Board on February 17, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Parking Analysis was guided by a Technical Advisory Group comprised of representative stakeholders who recommended receipt of the Analysis with the overarching goals to improve accessibility, ease communication, standardize regulations and improve enforcement;

WHEREAS, winter parking regulations are currently located within the Village Code within Article VII Parking Limits and Regulations of Chapter 500 Vehicles and Traffic;

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2021, within discussion of the requested update on implementation of the Analysis, the Village Board provided direction to staff to “Maintain winter parking regulations (December 1 – March 1), perform a sign audit for all areas currently posted, and eliminate signage where road [width] does not necessitate the regulation;”

WHEREAS, staff reviewed the existing regulations in conjunction within posted signage and street widths, and is recommending that the Village Code be updated to consistently prohibit winter parking within the Village on the east and north sides of streets that are less than 36 feet in width, with specified exceptions, as identified.

NOW THEREFORE, at a regular meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Shorewood, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, held on the 1st day of November 2021, by a favorable vote of the members being present and therefore, said Board does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1

Section 500-26 “Winter parking” of Article VIII “Parking Limits and Regulations” of Chapter 500 “Vehicles and Traffic” shall be amended to read as follows:

500-26 Winter parking.

A. No person shall park any vehicle on the east side or north side of any Village street between December 1 and February 28, annually, subject to posted regulations, snow emergency regulations and overnight parking restrictions, with the following exceptions:

(1) Parking shall be permitted on both sides of the street in the following blocks:

- (2) Parking shall be permitted on the north side of street and prohibited on the south side in the following streets, street segments or blocks:

- (3) Parking shall be permitted on the east side of street and prohibited on the west side on the following streets, street segments or blocks:

N. Maryland Avenue	East	From E. Capitol Drive to E. Kenmore Place
N. Morris Boulevard	East	From a point 15 feet north of the north crosswalk at E. Capitol Drive to a point approximately 110 feet north therefrom

N. Murray Avenue	East	From a point 15 feet south of the south crosswalk at E. Capitol Drive to a point 75 feet south therefrom
E. Olive Street	South	From a point 15 feet east of the east crosswalk at N. Oakland Avenue to a point approximately 70 feet east therefrom
N. Prospect Avenue	East	From a point 15 feet north of the north crosswalk at E. Capitol Drive to a point approximately 115 feet north therefrom
N. Woodburn Street	East	From a point 15 feet north of the north crosswalk at E. Capitol Drive to a point approximately 110 feet north therefrom

- B. No person shall park any vehicle on either side of E. Menlo Boulevard from N. Maryland Avenue to N. Downer Avenue between December 1 and February 28 from the point in time that snow or ice begins to fall and accumulate and through 10:00 a.m. of the morning after the precipitation has ceased.

SECTION 2

That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby to such extent repealed.

SECTION 3

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and posting commencing December 1, 2021.
